Send or fax the completed enrolment form to SEA at the address or fax
number above, or take the enrolment form to a SEA representative in your
country.

We will then send you an invoice for full fees payable. Send us your full
fees in Australian dollars including any optional fees.

If you are travelling on a Student Visa, when we have received your fees
we will send you a receipt and an electronic Confirmation of Enrolment
(eCoE). You need to take this to the Australian Embassy with a Student
Visa Application. Under the ESOS Act 2000 Amended, from 1st July 2012
if the course is more than 24 weeks 50% of the course tuition fees will be
payable before the course start date and the remaining 50% will be
payable 2 weeks before the start of the second study period. You also
have the right to pay more than 50% before your course commences.
If you are travelling on a Tourist or Working Holiday Visa, make sure you
leave enough time for the processing of your visa.

GENERAL ENGLISH: Fulltime

8.45am - 1.10pm / 2.00pm - 3.00pm

25 hours / week (includes 2 hours supervised study)

Our full time General English course focuses on spoken English, pronunciation, listening, reading and writing skills. Our aim is to develop your fluency, accuracy and confidence in these areas. Electives allow students to focus on subjects such as Grammar/Vocabulary extension/Pronunciation/Business English studies. Students' progress is assessed with a test at the end of each 4-week term, followed by a 1:1 interview with the class teacher.

Available to holders of Student, Tourist or Working Holiday visas.

GENERAL ENGLISH: Parttime

8.45am - 12.10pm 15 hours / week

Content as for full time course

Available to holders of Tourist or Working Holiday visas only.

CAMBRIDGE PREPARATION COURSES

8.45am - 1.10pm / 2.00pm - 3.00pm

25 hours / week (includes 2 hours supervised study)

These intensive courses prepare students for the internationally recognised Cambridge exams. Our students receive a high level of personal tuition, and can focus on individual problem areas both during supervised study and during regular interviews with their teacher. Electives focus on specific areas of need for the class such as speaking test practice, writing and exam technique.

These courses run for 10 or 12 weeks.

All courses include material fee, exam fee and certificate postage.

GENERAL ENGLISH: Full time EVENING

Our evening course begins at 4:15pm to 8:30pm (20 hours)

ENGLISH + ACTIVITIES

ENGLISH + SURFING

English Class - 15 hours / week

Plus 3 afternoons of surfing / week

Study English in the morning (8.45 - 12.10), then join surfing lessons at one of Manly's accredited surf schools for 2 hours in the afternoon. Lessons are conducted a few minutes' walk from the school and students are provided with surfboard and wetsuit. You'll be up and surfing in no time! Not available to student visa holders.

ENGLISH + DIVING

Students attend full time General English classes (25 hours/week) for two weeks while completing the PADI Dive course over two weekends.

Students must have an intermediate level of English or above.

Students must undergo a diving medical. This must be conducted by an Australian registered doctor. The cost of this is not included in the course price. Estimated price: \$60.

An extra fee of \$25 applies to requests for diving manuals in languages other than English. Not available to student visa holders.

JUNIOR PROGRAM

SEA's Junior program allows students aged 15 - 17 to join our General English classes for 20 hours per week from 8.45 to 1.10 each day (Monday to Friday) followed by one of our fun afternoon activities for four afternoons each week. These activities are designed to make the most of everything Manly Beach and Sydney has to offer. The afternoon activities are a mix of sporting, cultural and sightseeing activities. In addition there is a full day Saturday activity provided for those students also booking homestay accommodation. This program runs from 15/07/2019 to 16/08/2019 and can be booked for 1 to 5 weeks duration. Package A price includes enrolment fee, material fee, tuition, four weekday afternoon activities, guardianship service, homestay accommodation and return airport transfers. Package B price includes enrolment fee, material fee, tuition, four weekday afternoon activities and guardianship service. Weekly travel cards are not included in the package price and must be purchased by students independently.

COST OF LIVING

We estimate that students should budget for approximately \$20 000 per year, which covers accommodation, food and transport. This does not include tuition fees.

STUDENT WELFARE

At SEA we are always ready to help you. Whether you need help with your studies, planning your holiday, finding out more about Australia or further study opportunities, our experienced knowledgeable staff will be happy to advise you.

Under-18s have a scheduled fortnightly meeting with our Guardian.

ACCOMMODATION

Manly offers a great range of accommodation to suit every budget, including homestay (\$280/week), hostels (from \$40/night or \$255/week). Most of our visitors choose either homestay or hostel accommodation. Contact us for more information regarding hotel or guesthouse accommodation for single and twin share.

Prices quoted may be seasonally adjusted.

HOMESTAY

Staying with a homestay family is a great way to make Australian friends and keep practising your English.

At SEA we choose our homestay families very carefully to ensure that you have the best experience of home life during your stay in Manly.

Please note: You must book homestay accommodation at least 28 days before your arrival in Manly.

The minimum period for homestay accommodation is 2 weeks.

AIRPORT PICKUP

If you wish to be met by a SEA representative at Sydney's Kingsford Smith Airport, you will need to provide flight details (flight number, date and arrival time) at least 2 weeks before your arrival.

VISA REQUIREMENTS

To study at the Sydney English Academy you will need to apply for a Student, Tourist or Working Holiday Visa. A Student Visa will allow you to study for 2 to 50 weeks full time.

A Tourist Visa will allow you up to 12 weeks of study, and a Working Holiday Visa 17 weeks of study.

INSURANCE

If you are travelling on a Student visa, the Australian government requires that you must be covered by OSHC (Overseas Student Health Cover).

If you are travelling on a Tourist or Working Holiday visa, we strongly advise that you get travel and medical insurance to cover you and your belongings for the whole of your stay in Australia before leaving your country.

SOCIAL ACTIVITIES

Two non-compulsory social activities are offered to students each week. Most of these activities are free however some may require a small fee (\$5 - \$20) A great range of weekend excursions are also available.

INDIVIDUAL TUITION(1:1)

1:1 lessons can be arranged on application. These lessons are personally tailored to focus on your specific language needs (for example speaking and pronunciation), or your professional or personal areas of interest (for example Tourism, or Business).

SEA TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Cancellation and Refund Policy

Cancellations are effective only after they are received by SEA in writing. Requests must be made to the Director by email. An email response will be provided in 5 working days. If you cancel your course less than 28 days or more prior to course commencement then 100% of your course fee will be refunded excluding enrolment fee and accommodation placement fee. Less than 28 days prior to course commencement then 85% will be refunded less enrolment fee and accommodation placement fee. See below for further details regards refund of accommodation fees for cancellations less than 14 days before course commencement. If cancellation is made on or after the day of commencement of the proposed course then no refund will be made. Refunds will be paid within 4 weeks of cancellation notice date less any bank transfer fees incurred by SEA. If the provider defaults, any compulsory fees will be repaid within 2 weeks of the date of notification to the person or organization who initially paid the fees to SEA, less any bank fees incurred by SEA. If the student defaults, any compulsory fees will be repaid within 4 weeks. Course fees are non-transferable either to another student or institution.

DEFERMENT POLICY

If you defer your course commencement date, then later cancel your course prior to the new commencement date, the cancellation policy will apply from the original course commencement date, not the deferred commencement date. After your course has commenced, 2 weeks' notice must be given for all accommodation cancellations or a cancellation charge equal to 2 weeks rent will apply. Any unused accommodation fees will be refunded to the student within 2 weeks of submitting a refund request in writing. If you are asked to leave the homestay for any valid reason, for example due to unacceptable behaviour, a cancellation payment of 2 weeks' notice will be deducted from any refund due, in lieu of 2 weeks' notice. If the SEA cancels a course before its commencement, tuition fees and compulsory course fees will be refunded in full, 2 weeks from the date of default. If the SEA is unable to deliver the agreed services, then we will make a refund to the student in accordance with the relevant Commonwealth and/or State legislation. As an alternative to making a payment, SEA may arrange for another course, or part of a course, to be provided to the student at SEA's expense. If the student accepts this arrangement, SEA will be relieved of its liability to make the refund. This agreement does not remove the right to take further action under Australia's consumer protection laws. Students have the right to appoint a nominee to represent them in any dispute resolution process. If a resolution cannot be found to a dispute between the SEA and yourself, you will still retain the right to pursue whatever legal action is available to you under Australian law. If, in the unlikely event that SEA ceases to operate and is unable to provide a full refund, holders of valid student visas will be able to access the Tuition Protection Service (TPS) which offers an on-line placement and refund service for international students affected by such provider closures.

INDEMNITY AND RELEASE

I agree that the Sydney English Academy (SEA), its teachers, employees and/or appointed agents shall not be held responsible or liable and I will not make any claim against any of them for any damage, loss, delay or expense, bodily injury or death and/or property damages which I may suffer or cause in connection with, or during my attendance at any premises owned/leased/operated or controlled by the Sydney English Academy, and during my attendance at, and/or participation in any activities and/or excursions whether educational, cultural, sporting, recreational or otherwise arranged or conducted by the Sydney English Academy, and/or my participation in any accommodation, and/or airport transfers arranged for me. I agree that the law of the State of New South Wales in the Commonwealth of Australia shall apply to this agreement. The aforementioned shall extend to executors, administrators and assigns of the signatory.

AIRPORT PICKUP

Airport pickup fee will not be refunded if you fail to notify SEA of your flight details or change of these details, less than 48 hours before arrival, or fail to meet our Airport Pickup officer in the designated place at the designated time.

ADDITIONAL ACCOMMODATION POLICIES

Accommodation placement fees are non refundable. Notice to SEA of any postponement (delayed start date) or cancellation of accommodation services (homestay, hostel) must be received 14 days before the accommodation start date. If notice of postponement is received less than 14 days before the commencement date of your course, 2 weeks' accommodation fees will be charged. You need to disclose, at the time of enrolment, any medical problem or specific condition that may negatively impact on your homestay family accommodation (for example undisclosed dietary requirements). Most accommodation options do not accept arrival dates on the 25 December or 31st December or 1 January. Students will be charged a relocation homestay fee in the case where they wish to change homestay accommodation without what SEA considers to be a valid reason. Homestay and all other accommodation options are only confirmed for the period booked and paid for. Any extension of accommodation is dependent on availability. Internet can be requested for homestay placements and is a \$10 weekly fee paid directly to the family. An additional weekly fee may be required for specific dietary requests such as halal, vegan or gluten free. The relevant fee can be provided on application.

OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS

It is the student's responsibility to take out their own travel, accident and medical insurance for the full duration of their time in Australia. Any photos or footage taken at SEA or on excursions or activities by SEA staff or representatives are the property of SEA and may be used in the reproduction of material for promotional or

marketing use without consent. That students' personal information may be made available to Commonwealth and State agencies.

That students must notify SEA regarding any change of address or telephone number whilst enrolled at SEA. SEA only accepts students of the age of 16 or over.

The Sydney English Academy reserves the right to change courses, conditions, timetables and fees without notice, or to cancel or defer courses.

The Sydney English Academy reserves the right to cancel a course due to insufficient enrolments. I understand that all enrolments in ELICOS courses of 24 or fewer weeks constitutes as one course. Once I have commenced my course, I am not entitled to a refund for any unused weeks or tuition. I need to disclose, at the time of my enrolment, any medical problem or specific condition that may affect my ability to participate and complete the course I am applying for in accordance with the course requirements or that may negatively impact on SEA staff or other SEA students.

If I miss classes for personal reasons including illness, I understand no financial compensation or make up classes will be offered.

I understand that any poor conduct in my class which disrupts the delivery of lessons may result in the termination of my course. I must attend 80% of classes or I will be breaching student visa conditions.

The SEA must report any student with less than 80% attendance to the Australian Government Department of Immigration and Border Protection (DIBP) and this could result in a visa cancellation.

I understand that if I am on a student visa it is my responsibility to advise the SEA of my current residential address on arrival and if I change my address I must notify the College in writing immediately. I am aware that failure to notify the Centre that I have changed my address may result in automatic cancellation of my visa without my knowledge.

I must inform the SEA in writing if I do not wish to be photographed or videotaped and have these images used for marketing communications. Information is collected on this form and during your enrolment in order to meet our obligations under the ESOS Act and the National Code 2007, and to ensure student compliance with the conditions of their visas and their obligations under Australian immigration laws generally. The authority to collect this information is contained in the Education Services for Overseas Students Act 2000, the Education Services for Overseas Students Regulations 2001 and the National Code of Practice for Registration Authorities and Providers of Education and Training to Overseas Students 2007.

Information collected about you on this form and during your enrolment can be provided, in certain circumstances, to the Australian Government and designated authorities and, if relevant, the Tuition Protection Service Director. In other instances, information collected on this form or during your enrolment can be disclosed without your consent where authorized or required by law. Students consent to SEA making reasonable enquiries to DIBP regarding their visa and to sharing these details with Government and health Insurers for the purpose of ensuring that visa conditions for staying in Australia are maintained. SEA has the right to share information about your course and progress with your sponsor, university or college or educational representative.

INVOICES AND PAYMENTS

For all non-student visa enrolments, an invoice will be issued with a Letter of Offer. Payment in full should be made by a minimum of 28 days before commencement of the study program shown on the Letter of Offer or immediately if less than 28 days to commencement of your study program.

For all student visa enrolments of 24 weeks or less one invoice will be issued with a Letter of Offer and Enrolment Acceptance (EA). The EA should be signed by the student or their legal guardian (if under 18 years of age) and returned with full payment of the invoice. An electronic Confirmation of Enrolment (eCoE) will then be issued for the visa application. If you study a program of 25 weeks or more, you will be issued with an invoice covering the full study program with your Letter of Offer and EA. The invoice will include the tuition fees payable for each half of the study program and the due dates. Under the ESOS Act 50% of the tuition fees will be payable by the due dates shown on the Letter of Offer and invoice. Your eCoE will be forwarded to you after the payment has been received. The second payment will be due no later than the date shown on the Letter of Offer and invoice. You also have the right to pay more than the 50% of your tuition fees before your course commences. In both cases the EA must be signed by you or your legal guardian (if under 18 years of age) and returned with the appropriate payment. An eCoE will then be issued for the visa application. If the second payment has not been paid by the due date this may result in your eCoE being amended or cancelled and your case being reported to the Department of Immigration and Border Protection (DIBP) and the Tuition Protection Scheme Director once all appeal processes have been completed.
